### OVERVIEW OF THE ROLE

To supervise the provision of the football element of the course and to provide additional football activity sessions where required.

### RESPONSABILITIES

- Welcoming groups to the centre
- Enthusiastically promoting the activities programme
- Enthusiastically support the football element of the activities programme
- Monitoring the training provided by football coaches
- Ensuring that Twin provides the full quota of football training sold to our clients, and to provide additional football training/coaching wherever required
- Organising, supervising and animating a range of activities and excursions for students
- Preparing and planning activities in advance of sessions
- Attending all excursion, activity and staff meetings
- Advertising and explaining the programme to clients and creating and fostering learning through a range of activities
- Actively participating in and supervise students on excursions
- Arranging project work and cultural activities which result in a favourable learning outcome
- Supervising meals and other free time
- Performing residential evening patrols on a rota basis & ensuring students go to and stay in bed
- Assisting clients with any special requests and generally supporting senior centre staff in their duties
- Ensuring the health and safety and welfare of clients at all times, reporting accidents or near misses to the Centre Manager
- Maintain adequate levels of discipline
- Selling optional extra tours and activities
- Meeting and greeting groups at the airport
- Any other reasonable/appropriate duties

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**KNOWLEDGE/EXPERIENCE REQUIRED**

Essential requirements:

- Responsible
- Enthusiastic
- Creative
- Team player
- Desire and ability to make a decisive contribution to the programme

- Football coaching experience and certification

Desirable, but not essential:

- First aid certificate
- Life guarding license
- Experience of training sports professionally/sports coaching qualifications
- Experience of supervising minors

**EDUCATION/QUALIFICATION DESIRED**

- No formal qualifications are necessary. However, applicants should be at least 18 years old with the necessary maturity to undertake responsibility for groups of students aged between 10 and 18 years old.
